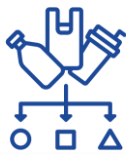




## Belgian Parliament

### Measures:



- Waste sorting and use of biodegradable bags (or recycled plastic garbage cans)
- Creation of a new room for hazardous waste
- Install a recycling system for cigarette butts



- Replacement of windows
- Insulation under windows and roofs



- Elimination of document binders for the commission meetings
- Electronic provision of brochures and information to members
- Electronic transmission of the Chamber's publications to members



- Relamping with LED lighting + presence detector and light sensor)
- Placement of solar panels



- Increase the number of charging stations for electric cars
- Increase available bicycle parking spaces
- Extension of the bicycle allowance for the use of an electric scooter
- Repair workshop with basic equipment to repair bikes



- Raise awareness among staff members through action days (Warm Sweater Day, Mobility Day,...)



- Provide a water leak detection system and install automatic anti-leak faucets
- Rainwater flush, rainwater taps for watering plants
- A water tank for the cleaning of service vehicles



- When replacing IT equipment, opt for more energy-efficient devices
- Strive to use only eco-labeled products
