- Building Automation System (BAS)
- Inverter-type air conditioning systems
- Low-energy glass cladding



- Water-saving feature sanitary fittings
- Rain water harvestings for garden tap irrigation system



- Building orientation optimising natural lighting
- Dedicated parking bays for green vehicle
- Grass paver block for outdoor parking bays
- Solar panels on rooftop (10% of electrical lighting supply)
